












Intercare is the school district's special investigations unit, or SIU.</p> <p>In a recorded statement to an investigator, Leon denied working elsewhere or earning income from another source while receiving benefits, Intercare said. Surveillance, however, showed that Leon was working at a medical clinic on several occasions from Sept. 25 to Oct. 9, 2010.</p> <p>A separate Intercare investigation led to the arrest of Hacienda La Puente School District payroll technician Victoria Jimenez late last month. She complained of pain in both arms, her neck and left shoulder in May 2009. After treatment, she was placed on modified duty the following October. The school district could not accommodate her work restrictions, so she was placed on total temporary disability.</p> <p>Intercare said it obtained surveillance starting in late 2009 through September 2010 that showed Jimenez engaged in physical activity that exceeded her work restrictions.
